



PRIME FOR LIFE (ACT) REQUIREMENTS

Effective: January 1, 2019

As part of the mandatory requirements for receiving a driving related offense, the court requires you to complete the Assessment Course Treatment (ACT)/Prime for Life Program (PFL) provided by Rimrock.

## Prime for Life/ ACT Program

SMOKING IS NOT ALLOWED ON RIMROCK PROPERTY AT ANY TIME.

**The total cost of the program is \$375.00 – No checks accepted**

___ 1)	<p><b>PAYMENT:</b> Make payment; <i>once we receive your referral from the court, probation, your lawyer or records and drivers control</i>, you may contact Rimrock at, <u>1231 N. 29<sup>th</sup> St.</u> or call 248-3175 ext. 434 to make your payment of \$375, which may be paid in two installments, \$200 to secure your intake enrollment. At this time the intake session will be scheduled.</p>										
___ 2) INTAKE (1 hour)	<p><b>INTAKE (1 hour):</b> Attend intake; Rimrock/Silverleaf located at, <u>1331 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue N.</u> (arrive 5 minutes early, late arrivals will not be permitted and will need to be rescheduled). ___ 3)	<p><b>SUBSTANCE USE EVALUATION (1 hour):</b> Attend substance use evaluation at Rimrock/Silver Leaf located at <u>1331 1<sup>st</sup> Ave. N.</u> (be here 5 minutes early). If you have completed treatment outside of Rimrock, please bring completion documentation to this appointment. At the end of this appointment, a referral appointment will be scheduled. Final payment is due prior to attending this appointment. Failure to make this payment will result in the appointment being rescheduled. You can pay in person at the main facility located at <u>1231 N. 29<sup>th</sup> St.</u> or call 248-3175 ext. 434, final payment is \$175.00.</p>										
___ 4)	<p><b>Referral Appointment (30 minutes):</b> We will go over your evaluation and recommendations and sign paperwork.</p>
