Vietnam era veteran also includes any veteran of the U.S. military, ground, naval, or air service who served in the Republic of Vietnam between February 28, 1961 and May 7, 1975. <u>"Special Disabled Veteran"</u> is entitled to compensation under laws administered by the Department of Veterans Affairs for a disability rated at 30 percent or more; or, rated at 10 or 20 percent, if it has been determined that the individual has a serious employment disability. or, a person who was discharged or released from active duty because of a service-connected disability. <u>"Disabled Veteran"</u> served on active duty in the U.S. military ground, naval, or air service and is entitled to disability compensation (or who but for the receipt of military retired pay would be entitled to disability compensation) under laws administered by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, or was discharged or released from active duty because of a service-connected disability. <u>"Recently Separated Veteran"</u> is any veteran who served on active duty during the three-year period beginning on the date of such veteran's discharge or release from active duty. <u>"Other Protected Veteran"</u> is any other veteran who served on active duty in the U.S. military ground, naval, or air service during a war or in a campaign or expedition for which a campaign badge has been authorized. <u>"Armed Forces Service Medal Veteran"</u> is a veteran who, while serving on active duty in the U.S. military ground, naval, or air service, participated in a United States military operation for which an Armed Forces service medal was award
